*Discussion on re-opening of the schools.

Since no order has been received from Delhi Govt. and the circular received from DoE states that school can only be re-opened after 30th September. We will wait till we receive clear cut guidelines or instructions from Delhi Govt. regarding re-opening of the school. The schools will reopen in the month of October, 2020.

Many Principals shared that they have already circulated the Google form and also undertaken the polls in order to obtain consent from the parents regarding sending their children to school. Most of the schools received the feedback that the parents are not keen to send their children to school and they are quite happy with the online classes.

Once we receive an order from Delhi Govt. we have to re-open the school and it is the choice of the parents to send or not to send their children to the school.

- *Discussion on how to conduct examinations in the schools for classes IX to XII Before conducting the exams certain measures have to be undertaken by the school authorities.
- -Sanitizing stations to be provided.
- -Entry and exit plan to be formulated.
- -Guards at the gate should be instructed accordingly.
- Time slot of the examination has to be prepared and circulated.
- Local authorities should be brought into picture such as SHO and CMO so that they can make a visit to the school and do the ground check.
- Students need to bring a medical certificate/medical declaration form.
- If any child found with symptoms, would be advised to do home quarantine and not attend school till he\she is physically fit.

- No school transport will be provided to the students.
- Schools can plan to call students of science stream to give the practicals and Commerce students to submit their projects.

- Provision of masks and sanitizers.
