Ms. Sudha Acharya, President welcomed everyone and conveyed her best wishes on the World Environment Day. She said that all the school are working and doing so much to keep a balance to our ecological system, doing activities keeping in mind the sustainable development goals and in line with this year's theme 'Eco Restoration'.

### **Agenda No. 1**

– Cancellation of class XII Boards Examinations and how the chidden should be assessed

- It was decided that since class X is the only valid and standardized mark sheet which the schools have, therefore, weightage to class X should be given that also becomes the differentiator.

- It was also decided that most of the schools have completed the practicals or can complete via online mode so weightage to the practicals and internal exams including pre-boards should be given. She said that what she has proposed the following weightage:

-20% -class X

-30%-Practicals

-50%-Pre-boards

along with to take 3 years school profile, subject average, and school average but eliminate the distribution grid as it will not be possible for the schools to provide.

- Most of the members were in the agreement to the above weightage decided. Since CBSE has asked the schools to share their suggestions through Google Form so all the schools decided to forward the same to CBSE.
- On discussing about 'Way Head' Ms. Sudha Acharya shared that we will be having restructured and redesigned CCE pattern. The reason behind calling off the CCE pattern was that there were a lot of loopholes and our teachers were not trained and they got busy in procuring documents only and teaching was somehow could not take place. But now when we will bring CCE with revised and restricted manner and if the mid-term examinations have to happen and everyone is talking about project based learning, students can chose one project term wise along with other subjects from his/her immediate environment of their choice and either by record, podcast, documentary or whichever manner can present it. Only then there would be the impact of that project on the child and on the immediate environment. if midterm exams have to happen then we but with the revised and restricted pattern and inclusion of art integration in the subjects and project based learning
- We also need OTBA and it is very important that our teachers get training. It is even applicable in case studies.

- She further talked about the holistic progress card and the committee is working on it. In holistic assessment all the 21st century skills are coming and among them the communication skills is the most important one as through that children are expressing themselves.
- Art integration through projects was also discussed.

## **Agenda No. 2**

- Adding other Boards in the schools

- She further apprised that CBSE Affiliation BY Laws are going to be revisited soon and the schools will get a Google form and the school leaders need to send their opinion for having multiple boards in the school campus.
- NEP also talks about shared school campuses. Many Dwarka schools are sharing their school grounds or ATL Labs with Govt. schools or NGOs.
